



THE WORLD'S FIRST COMPLETE WORMING PROGRAM

SUGGESTED HORSE WORMING PROGRAM

- A minimum of 1 faecal egg count (FEC) per season.
- Assume 2 wormings per season.

This is an **EXAMPLE ONLY** and depends on the age of the animal, season, stocking rates, grazing pressure and location.

- BioWorma and Livamol with BioWorma to be fed for a minimum of 60 days. Recommended for strategic use during periods when weather conditions are conducive to larval development and transmission onto pasture at temperatures above 5°C.

Anthelmintic worm control (Treatment)

FEC's are **NOT** an indication of how many worms the horse has! They should be used to assess the amount of contamination each horse contributes to the pasture.

0-300 epg = LOW: FEC again next season

300-500 epg = MODERATE: Treat with suitable chemical wormer, FEC again next season

500+ epg = HIGH: Treat with suitable chemical wormer, FEC again next season

1+ epg Ascarids: Always treat with suitable chemical wormer. Ascarids can cause depression, respiratory disease, stunted growth, diarrhea, constipation and colic.
